Rail Service

Canadian National, Kansas City Southern and Union Pacific currently operate routes in Ascension Parish with connections throughout the southern United States. Among the U.S. Class I railroads, KCS has the shortest route between Kansas City, the

second largest rail hub in the country, and the Gulf of Mexico. KCS also boasts the Meridian Speedway from Dallas, Texas to Meridian, Mississippi, which is the fastest-growing and least-congested east west route in the country. Canadian National serves the chemical industry in the parish and surrounding region, shipping product to Mexico, Houston, Dallas, Atlanta, and into the northeast.

Port Facilities

Ascension Parish is within 45 miles of the three deepwater ports on the Mississippi River including the Port of Greater Baton Rouge, Port of New Orleans, and Port of South Louisiana, one of the top 3 container ports in the world. Each has infrastructure and facilities in place to handle goods by ship and barge, truck and rail, as well as storage facilities for dry and cold goods.

Air Service

Ascension Parish is just 30 minutes from the Baton Rouge Metropolitan and New Orleans International airports offering over 150 domestic and international flights a day from airlines including AirCanada, Alaska, Allegiant, American, Air

Express, Condor, Copa, Delta, Frontier, Glo, jetBlue, Southwest, Spirit, United and Vacation Express. The airports also have cargo space for handling dry and cold goods. Travelers to the parish and capital region have the best of both worlds by also having access to international flights and additional domestic flights through the New Orleans International Airport (10,080 ft. runway and cargo facilities.)
